A self-governing organisation of German universities:

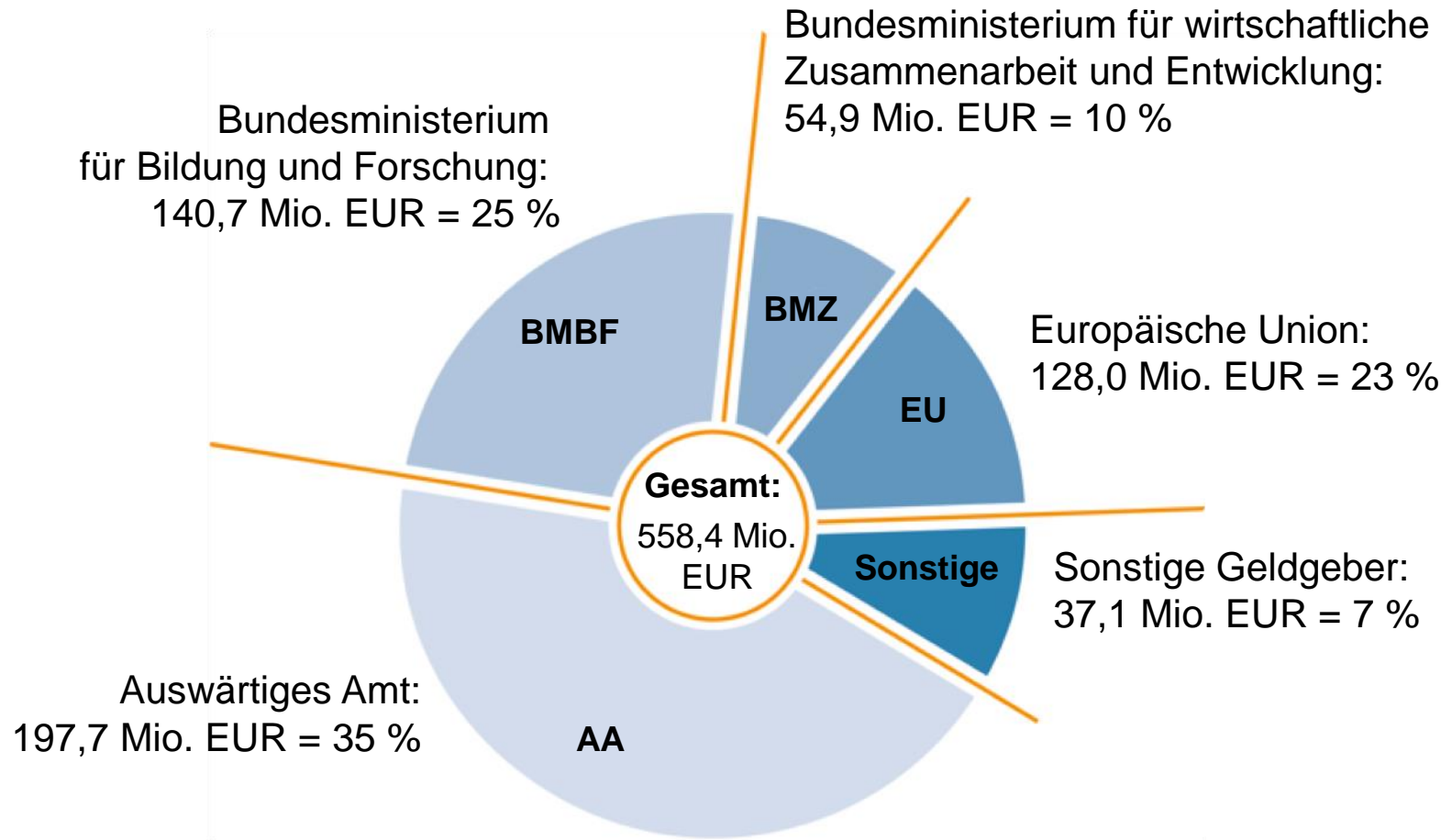
- 241 member universities

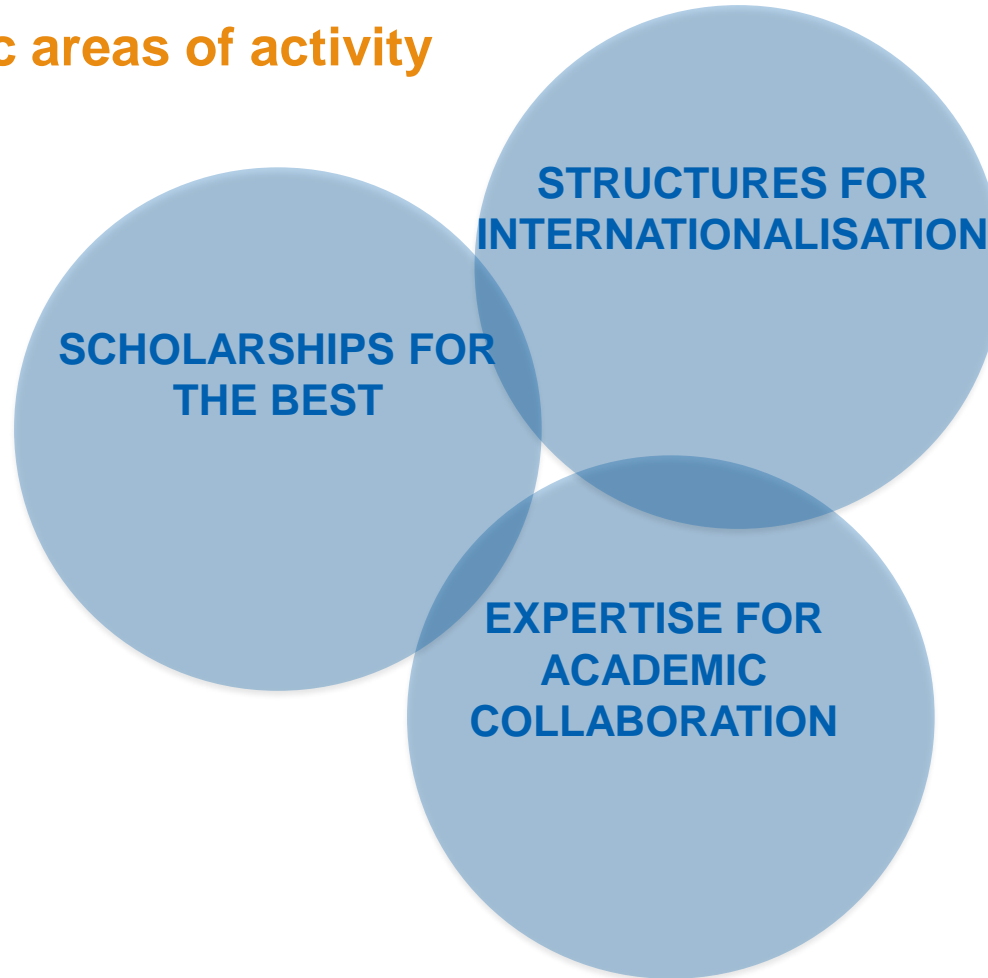

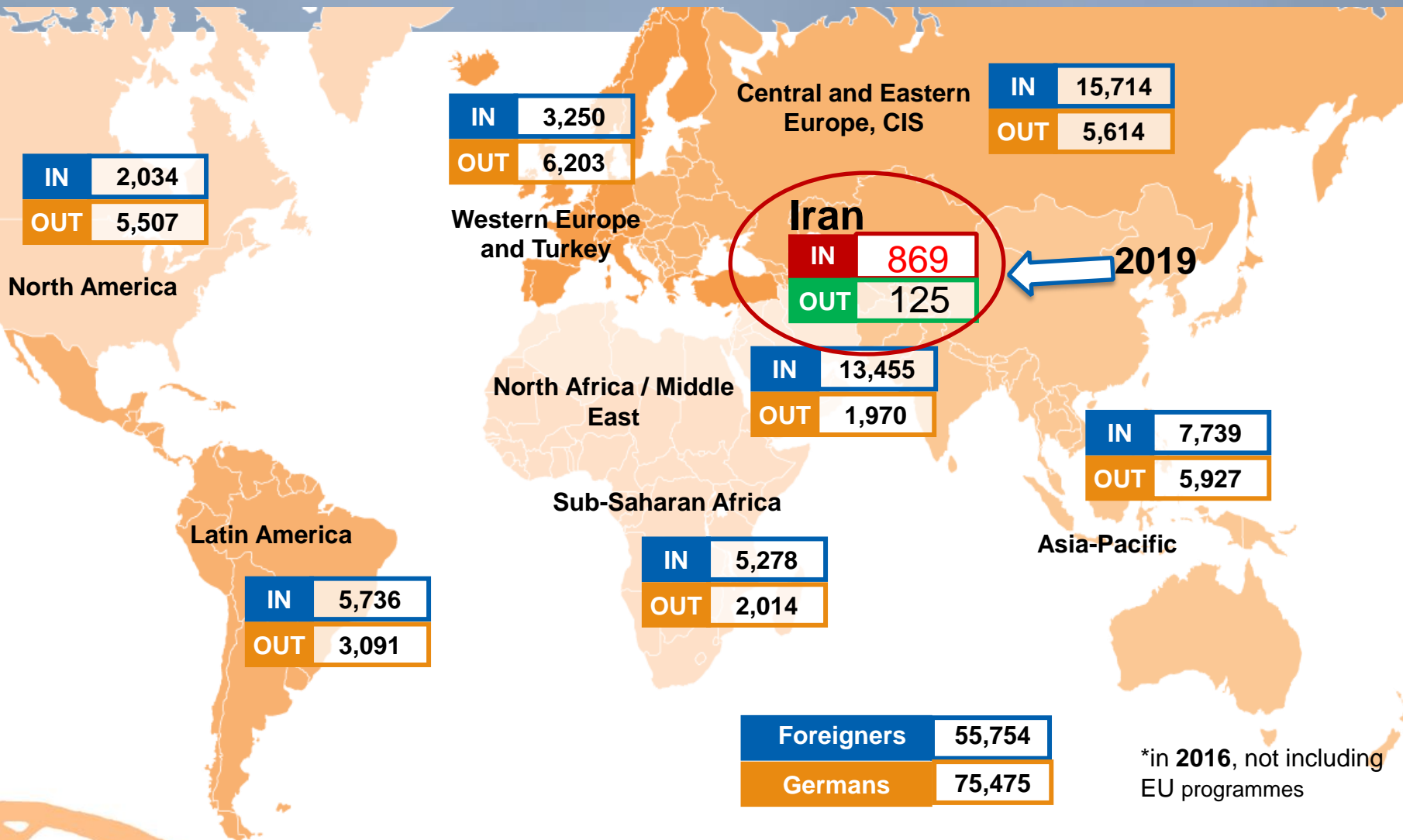

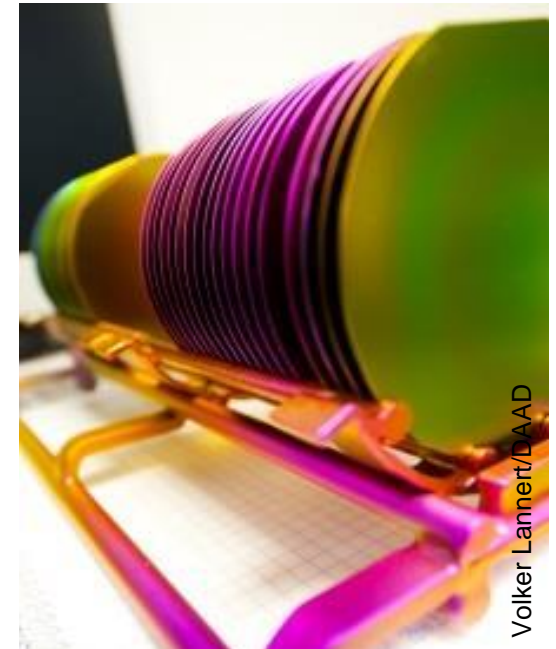

Language skills: German or English?

German is the language of instruction for most degree programmes at German universities.

But: Universities introduced a great number of English-taught programmes, aka “**International Programmes**”.



DAAD Scholarships



- Funding for study abroad or thesis research
- No subject-related quota
- Previous knowledge of German not required, but advantageous
- Monthly stipend
- Health Insurance
- Travel reimbursement
- All-Grantees meeting in Bonn
- No scholarships for undergraduates ☹️

Study Scholarship for Artists & Musicians



- Fields: **Performing Arts, Fine art, Design/Visual Communication, Film, Music and Architecture**
- Graduates
- Between 10 and 24 months
- € 850/monthly, health insurance, travel reimbursement
- ***Deadline: September, October, November***

Development-Related Postgraduate Courses (EPOS)

- **In Brief** Master's degree at a state or state-recognised German university, and in exceptional cases to take a doctoral degree, and to obtain a university qualification (Master's/PhD) in Germany
- **Who** Graduates with at least two years' professional experience
- **Duration** 12 to 36 months
- **Value** 750 _ 1000 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** Depending on chosen study programme; please check scholarship brochure or the website of your chosen study programme

Paths to a PhD

Individual vs. structured PhD

Individual PhD

- Individual research under supervision of supervisor
- Optional courses or other forms of teaching / learning
- Mostly informal admission and marginal formalisation

Structured PhD

- Guidance by a team of supervisors / supervising committee
- Mandatory, fixed supporting curriculum (interdisciplinary)
- Defined application process
- Offered by research training groups / graduate schools

Research grants – Doctoral programs in Germany

- **In Brief** Doctoral project (individual or structured programme) at a state-run or state- recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- **Who** Graduates, Doctoral candidates, Postdoctoral researchers
- **Duration** Up to 4 years
- **Value** 1,200 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X

Research grants – One-year and short-term grants

- **In Brief** Research or training project at a state-run or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- **Who** Graduates, Doctoral candidates, Postdoctoral researchers
- **Duration** One-year grants: 7_10 months
Short-term grants: 1_6 months
- **Value** 1,200 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X

Research grants – Binationally supervised doctoral degrees

- **In Brief** Doctoral degree at home university with integrated research phases in Germany
- **Who** Doctoral candidates
- **Duration** Up to 2 years
- **Value** Grant: 1,200 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X

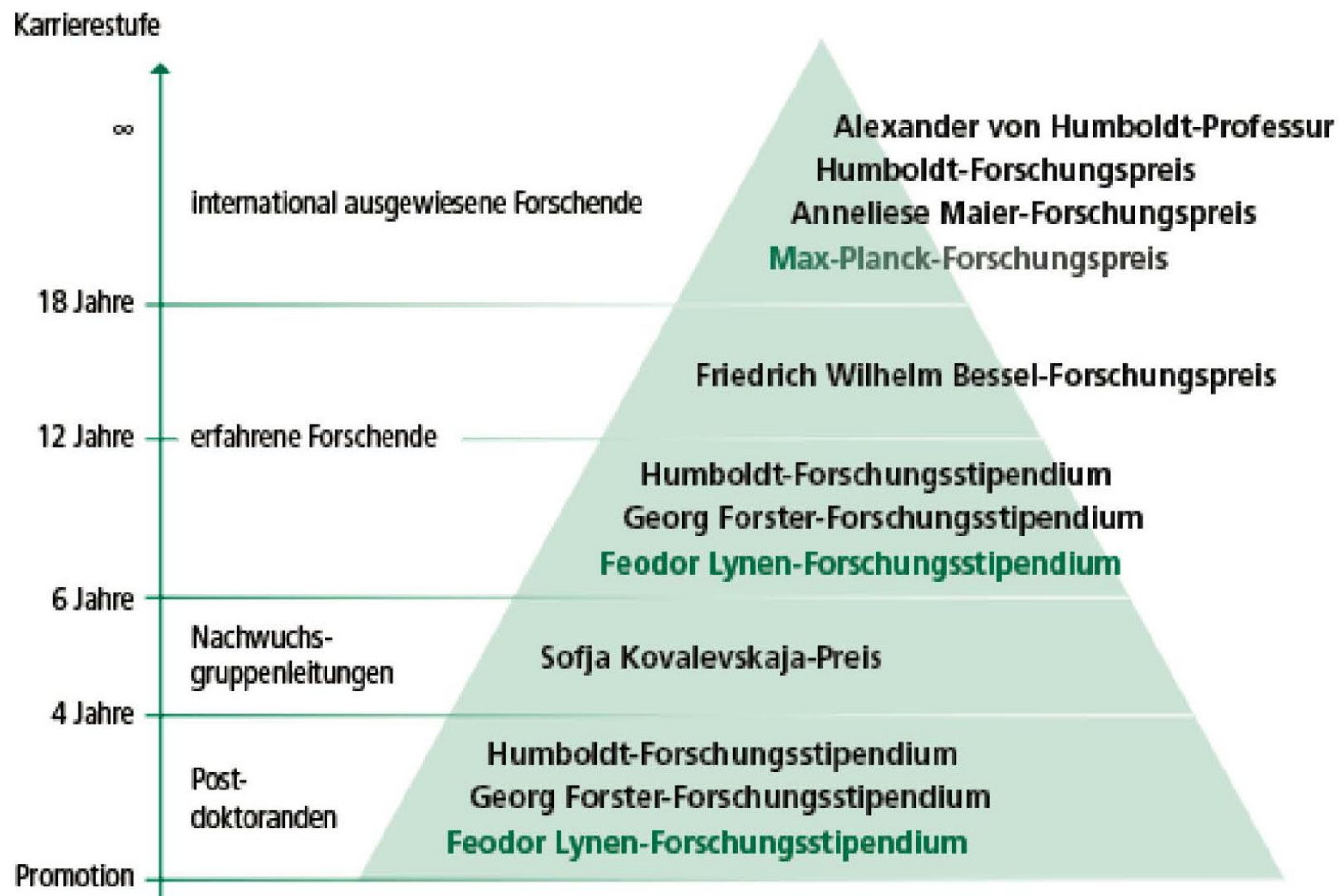
Re-invitation programme for former scholarship holders

- **In Brief** Research and work projects at a state-run or state-recognised HEI or non-university research institute
- **Who?** PhD students
Postdocs / Junior researchers
Senior researchers
- **Duration?** 1–3 months
- **Value?** Fellowship: 2,000–2,150 €/month + travel allowances

Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience (PRIME)

- **In Brief** to support the international mobility of postdoctoral researchers by temporary positions at German universities in place of conventional scholarships.
- **Who?** Postdocs
- **Duration?** 18 months (12 abroad / 6 Germany)
- **Value?** 3500€ - 4500€

- **Duration?** 1–3 months
- **Value?** Fellowship: 2,000–2,150 €/month + travel allowances

- Vortragsreisenprogramm
- Kongressreisenprogramm

Group study visit

- Financial support for academic information visits to Germany for groups of students
- Requirements:
 - Group of 10 to 15 students plus one accompanying faculty member
 - Trip for 7 to 12 days
 - Visit should be organized entirely by the home institution
 - Application: filed by a faculty member, including total budget, a detailed itinerary, specific information about relationship to the curriculum, application form



Deadlines: November 1 (for trips between March 1 and June 1 of the following year)

February 1 (for trips between June 1 and September 1 of the same year)

May 1 (for trips no earlier than September 1 of the same year)
